824.01 GARAGE SALE DEFINED.

As used in this chapter, "garage sale" means the display or advertisement for sale, by auction or otherwise, of four or more articles of tangible personal property at any residence or accessory structure, porch, garage or yard, whether in a commercial or residential zoning district within the Village. (Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.02 PERMIT REQUIRED.
No person shall conduct a garage sale without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Health Officer and without first paying the required fee as provided in Section 824.03.
(Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.03 PERMIT APPLICATION; FEE.
An application for a garage sale permit shall be submitted to the Village Clerk and must be approved by the Health Officer, prior to issuance, after payment of a fee of two dollars (\$2.00).
(Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.04 PERMIT APPLICATION DEADLINE; SALES AFTER SUNSET PROHIBITED.

An application for a permit required by this chapter shall be made at least seven days in advance of the first day of the sale. No sale shall be conducted either in whole or in part after sunset. (Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

PERMIT ISSUANCE; PERIOD OF VALIDITY.

Only two garage sale permits shall be issued for a single address in any twelvemonth period, and such permits shall be valid for not more than two consecutive days.

(Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.06 DISPLAY OF PERMIT.

Every person licensed under this chapter shall have his or her license in his or her possession at all times when conducting a sale and shall display the same upon demand of any police officer and upon demand of any person who attends such sale. (Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.07 PERMIT REFUSAL.

The Health Officer may refuse to issue the permit required for any garage sale which, in his or her judgment, would be detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the community or to the residential character of the neighborhood, it being the intent of this chapter to restrict such sales to casual sales of reasonably limited amounts of tangible personal property. (Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.08 ADVERTISING SIGNS.

A sign or placard announcing a garage sale may be erected only on the premises at which the sale is being conducted and shall be erected only for the duration of the sale. Such sign or placard shall be not larger than four square feet and shall be without illumination, movement or illusion of movement. (Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.09 SALES UNDER COURT ORDER EXEMPTED.

This chapter shall not apply to the sale of tangible personal property made under court order. (Ord. 88-2. Passed 1-11-88.)

824.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter shall be fined not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation or noncompliance occurs or continues.
