ORDINANCE NUMBER 2024 - 04

ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE GUIDANCE ON THE ELIGIBILITY FOR LABOR COSTS FOR PERMANENT, TEMPORARY, AND CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEES WHO PERFORM EMERGENCY WORK UNDER THE ROBERT T. STAFFORD DISASTER RELIEF EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE ACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in the Village of Brookside, Ohio, all elected officials receive a full-time salary, including the Mayor, Council members and Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, FEMA requires all elected Village officials to commit to NIMS education and requires them to be dedicated to be on the job in emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, the Village's full-time employees receive pay on a 40-hour pay basis and receive reimbursement on a time and a half basis for any work performed over 40 hours per week.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BROOKSIDE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That this policy applies to all federal disaster declarations that occur within the Village of Brookside.

Section 2: That all elected officials including the Mayor, Council Members, and Fiscal Officer shall be compensated for work performed during emergency situations as set forth above at the rate of \$25.00 per hour.

Section 3: That all full-time Village employees shall receive compensation at the rate of time and a half for any time they perform emergency work over 40 hours per week.

Section 4: That all emergency service personnel who perform work under the Stafford Act shall receive compensation for work performed during emergency situations at the rate of \$25.00 per hour.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety an welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Brookside and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

PASSED at a meeting of the Council of the Village of Brookside on this Handay of May, 2024, by the affirmative vote of 5 members of the Council.
